

## What does ConnectYourCare, LLC, do with your personal information?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or services you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number and employment information</li> <li>• Name, address, and other personal information</li> <li>• Medical information</li> <li>• Account balances and transaction history</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ConnectYourCare chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does ConnectYourCare protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. How does ConnectYourCare collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open an account or make deposits or withdrawals from your account(s)</li><li>• Use your debit card</li><li>• Use our web sites</li></ul> We may also collect your personal information from others, such as affiliated partner health plans, your employer, the Social Security Administration, and public records to comply with government requirements to know our customers.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes</li><li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li><li>• Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li></ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply individually unless you tell us otherwise. Any account holder may express a privacy preference on behalf of the other joint account holder(s).

## Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Our affiliates include financial companies with ConnectYourCare in their name such as ConnectYourCare, Inc., as well as companies within UnitedHealth Group, including Optum Bank and those companies that share the Optum name; financial companies such as OptumHealth Financial Services and UnitedHealthCare Insurance Company; nonfinancial companies such as OptumInsight and UHG Print Services; and others such as United HealthCare Services, Inc. and Optum Specialty Benefits, Inc.</li></ul>

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ConnectYourCare does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</li></ul>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ConnectYourCare does not jointly market.</li></ul>
